Contributions are not deductible for federal income tax purposes. An individual may not contribute more than a total of \$6,600 (\$3,300 primary \$3,300 general). A couple may contribute up to \$13,200 from a joint account. A multi-candidate federal PAC may contribute up to \$10,000 (\$5,000 primary / \$5,000 general). All contributions will be attributed first to the Primary election, with any amount exceeding the limit automatically redesignated to the General election. Federal election law prohibits contributions from the general treasury funds of a corporation, labor organization or national bank, from any person contributing another's fund, from a federal government contractor or from a foreign national who lacks permanent resident status.
